

CI Plus DEVICE INTERIM LICENSE AGREEMENT

Notice to Potential Licensees

The Device Interim License Agreement dated 13th July 2009 is suitable for **either** a Licensed Product **or** a Licensed Component application.

A CI Plus Component License allows a CI Implementer to access CI Plus Test Credentials and Certificates. CI Plus Test Credentials and Certificates can be used to build completely functional **test versions** of CI Plus Component or Products. It should be noted that CI Plus Approved Testing is carried out on products using only CI Plus Test Credentials and Certificates.

CI Plus implementers who complete a Licensed Component application (by checking one of the boxes at section 1.23) are provided access to CI Plus Test Credentials and Certificates under the terms of this License Agreement. CI Plus Component Licensees are not required to pay the CI Plus Licensee fee but are required to pay a shipping and handling fee for CI Plus Test Credentials and Certificates

CI Plus implementers who wish to commercially deploy CI Plus Products are required to complete a CI Plus Licensed Product Application (by checking one of the boxes at section 1.24), pay the CI Plus License Fee and complete the CI Plus On-Boarding and Device Registration process as explained below.

Existing CI Plus Component Licensees are required to complete a separate CI Plus Product License Application if they wish to move to a commercial deployment of CI Plus Product.

The CI Plus Component License is an **optional** step for CI Plus Implementers providing early access to CI Plus Test Credentials and Certificates, under the terms of this License Agreement, in advance of completing a full CI Plus License application. It is envisaged that some categories of CI Plus Implementers, for example Test Tool or Software Stack Vendors, will only ever require CI Plus Component Licenses.

CI Plus Implementers who intend to commercially deploy CI Plus Products are provided access to the same CI Plus Test Credentials and Certificates under the CI Plus Licensed Product Application. Such implementers might not benefit from the optional CI Plus Component License and may prefer to move directly to a CI Plus Product License.

Application and On-Boarding Procedure

Please complete and sign 2 copies of **either** a Licensed Product **or** a Licensed Component Interim License Agreement, after reading the notes below, and return to:

CI Plus Licensed Component Applicants, please check the relevant box at section 1.23 designating **the licensed COMPONENT category - HOST or MODULE**. Your signed Interim License Agreement will be filed by TC Trust Center and you will not receive any On-Boarding documentation. If you require any Test credentials, they are available from TC Trust Centre on application and payment of the fees as shown in Exhibit I, section 5.1.

If you later decide to register a CI Plus Product, you will need to re-apply to TC Trust with a revised Interim License Agreement as a CI Plus Licensed Product Application.

CI Plus Licensed Product Applicants, please check the relevant box at section 1.24 designating **the licensed PRODUCT category - HOST or MODULE**. Note that Licensed Product Licensees are granted an automatic Product Component License under the terms and restrictions defined in the License Agreement.

Please note that the company vetting procedures to finalise the on-boarding process may take several weeks for completion, therefore it is recommended to carefully read and understand the On-Boarding procedures and consider the most efficient time to start such preparations to ensure Key and Certificate availability for product shipment.
